

Horse Show Conditions of Entry

- No Liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
- 2. Stallions and colts 2 years and over must be bitted at all times and not shown by anyone under 16 years old.
- 3. Definition of Novice is: Neither horse or Rider has been placed 1st in a jumping competition this season.
- Classes are limited and will close 15 minutes before the scheduled time.
- 5. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedule, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
- Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, the
 wearing of spurs or other actions where the Judges or Officials consider warrants such
 penalty.
- Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear protective headgear conforming to PAS 015 & BSI Kitemark, VG1 01.040 & BSI Kitemark, ASTM F 1163 & SEI mark, SNELL E2001 or E2016 & official SNELL label and number, AS/NZS 3838 & SAI Global mark. Such headgear must be worn properly secured.
- 8. All horses being ridden on the showground must be 4 years or older.
- 9. No pony or horse may be ridden twice in the same class, except in the clear round jumping.
- The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 11. Entries may be refused without reason being given. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any rider or horse/pony found to be entered in a class they are not entitled to enter.
- 12. A refund (less admin fee) will be issued for withdrawn entries on production of a medical/veterinary certificate or at the Secretary's discretion.
- 13. Change of horse and/or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void.
- 14. Any rider galloping on the field will be asked to leave.
- 15. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules our Stewards and Officials are there to help and advise.
- 16. In the unlikely event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded but the organisers reserve the right to make a deduction to help cover their unrecoverable costs.
- 17. Cups and trophies remain the property of the show. Winners must sign for them agreeing to their safe custody and ensure their return for the next year's show no later than 1st August.
- 18. It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that any child who may have been injured is taken to the first aider.


